

Street Photography

Street photography features incidences and unmediated encounters that occur within the public domain. Street photographers make images that illuminate facets of society that aren't readily obvious to the naked eye.

It is important to distinguish between what is ethical and what is legal. Something can be ethical but not legal and vice versa. Relevant laws vary from place to place, even between parts of the same country, and ignorance of the law is generally no excuse. Organisations exist in many countries to provide free guidance to artists about complying with local laws.
